- Provided, programmed, and maintained by ES&S.
- Located in county clerk's office.


3. Polling-place equipment

- Tabulator (the 'voting machine' – DS200); and Ballot-marking device (BMD – ExpressVote)
- Owned, maintained, stored by municipalities;
- Programmed by county clerk, using an app provided by ES&S
- Located in polling places on Election Day; stored at various sites.

Also:


Portable USB drives to transfer data, software; whatever equipment the factory uses; Microsoft software for the operating system; and probably more.
